# ELECTIONS BC – Who We Are

- A.k.a. Office of the Chief Electoral Officer
  - Keith Archer, PhD, appointed September 1, 2011
- Independent Office of the legislature
- Responsible for:
  - Administering the provincial electoral processes and the initiative process
  - Voter registration
  - Political entity registration and financial reporting

## **VISION**

To be leaders in electoral administration

## **MISSION**

To serve democracy in BC through the fair and impartial administration of the provincial electoral process

## **MANDATE**

To administer the provincial electoral process in BC in accordance with the Election Act, Recall and Initiative Act, Referendum Act and Constitutional Amendment Approval Act

# Accountability

---

- Election authority answerable to government and governed
- With decision-making authority comes responsibility for professionalism

- Not dependent on current political authority.
- Separate authority to conduct business
- Access to sufficient funding to conduct required work

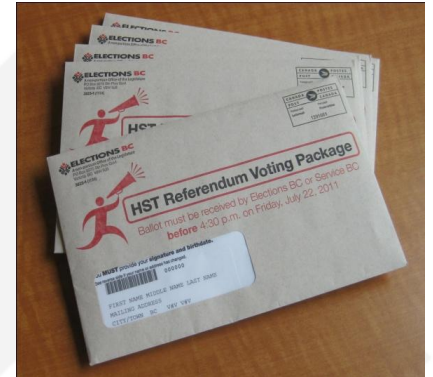
