The In-SHUCK-ch governing body is the In-SHUCK-ch Council, made up of each band's duly constituted council. With four council members per band, this creates a governing body of twelve.

#### 3. Who are the aboriginal people represented by the First Nation?

The First Nation constituents are members of Samahquam, Skatin and Douglas Indian Bands.

#### 4. How many aboriginal people are represented by the First Nation?

The aboriginal people represented in this statement of intent are all members of the current Indian bands: Samahquam (280 members, 80 onreserve), Skatin (536 member, 76 on-reserve) and Douglas (207 members, 55 on-reserve). A total of 1023 aboriginal people are represented in this Statement of Intent.
