continuing southwest to include the Brem River, the Quatum River, Maurelle Island, and a portion of Quadra Island. Klahoose Territory includes the water bodies of Strait of Georgia, Sutil Channel, Calm Channel, Desolation Sound, Pryce Channel, Homfray Channel, and Toba Inlet. Major land bodies within Klahoose Territory include Savary Island, Hernando Island, a portion of Malaspina Peninsula, Marina Island, Cortes Island, a portion of Quadra Island, Read Island, Maurelle Island, Raza Island, Redonda Islands; and the drainage basins of Forbes Creek, Powell River, Toba River, Tahumming River, Brem River and Quatum River.
